

Philip Scribano, DO, MSCE is Professor of Clinical Pediatrics at the Perelman School of Medicine, University of Pennsylvania, Director for Social Care Innovation in the Division of General Pediatrics at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) and holds the Shanahan Family Endowed Chair in Pediatrics. He also currently serves as a Physician Advisor for the CHOP Digital Health Initiative and is the Clinical Lead for the Clinical Quality and Safety Core of the Center for Health Equity at CHOP. His leadership includes his role as former Section Chief of Safe Place: Center for Child Protection and Health and provides direction in addressing health related social needs as a key child maltreatment prevention strategy, Dr. Scribano is currently working towards greater integration of social care into a pediatrics healthcare system.

Dr. Scribano has been honored at Penn into the Academy of Master Clinicians in 2021 which recognizes those clinicians who exemplify the highest standards of clinical excellence, humanism and professionalism and is the highest clinical honor to be bestowed on a Penn physician. And, in 2023, he was bestowed the Leonard Tow Humanism in Medicine Award. After 12 years as Section Chief for the Center for Child Protection and Health at CHOP, and a total of 23 years in this leadership position during his career, he has retired that distinguished leadership role as he focuses on his work in social care innovation.

Dr. Scribano has devoted his scholarly efforts in the areas of epidemiology and prevention of child maltreatment and intimate partner violence, technology use in healthcare, and health services to children in foster care. He has published over 100 original articles and book chapters and has been funded for multiple program and research grants from the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality, the Centers for Disease Control, U.S. Administration on Children and Families, and U.S. Department of Justice, as well as generous private foundations for this work. He has served in various roles on multiple national and international committees and organizations including the Ray Helfer Society, American Academy of Pediatrics, Academic Pediatric Association, Academy on Violence and Abuse, Child USA, Prevent Child Abuse America, and is currently serving on the Social Determinants of Health Advisory Board for Epic.
